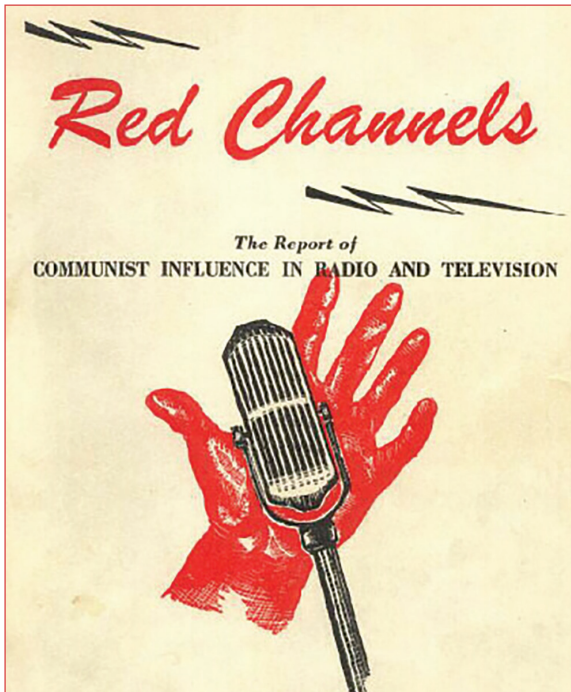

Carol Stabile, interim director of CSWS, will talk about her research, followed by discussion. A professor in the UO School of Journalism and Communication and head of the Department of Women’s and Gender Studies, she is the author of *Feminism and the Technological Fix*, editor of *Turning the Century: Essays in Media and Cultural Studies*, co-editor of *Prime Time Animation: Television Animation and American Culture*, and author of *White Victims, Black Villains: Gender, Race, and Crime News in US Culture*. She recently finished a book on women writers and the broadcast blacklist in the 1950s and is working on research on gender in massively multiplayer online games. She is also a founding member of Fembot, a scholarly collaboration promoting research on gender, media, and technology.
