
## **A CSWS NOON TALK** "G-Men Masculinity: The FBI's War on Broadcasting" **CAROL STABILE**

Carol Stabile, interim director of CSWS, will talk about her research, followed by discussion. A professor in the UO School of Journalism and Communication and head of the Department of Women's and Gender Studies, she is the author of *Feminism and the* Technological Fix, editor of Turning the Century: Essays in Media and Cultural Studies, co-editor of Prime Time Animation: Television Animation and American Culture, and author of White Victims. Black Villains: Gender. Race. and Crime News in US Culture. She recently finished a book on women writers and the broadcast blacklist in the 1950s and is working on research on gender in massively multiplayer online games. She is also a founding member of Fembot, a scholarly collaboration promoting research on gender, media, and technology.
